We made rainbow sun catchers for our classroom windows and paper plate rainbows that are displayed outside our door. This week's table activities consisted of beading, matching, and putting things together. For



centers time we were able to paint a rainbow at the easel, work with colored magnets and laminated rainbow strips at the light table, grab and fill using shredded rainbow colored paper, cut up colored straws and cups in the sensory table, and use blocks, bears and a plastic rainbow on the train table. Toilet training is going great! Please let us know if you have any concerns or questions. It is perfectly normal for children to step back a bit during the toilet training process.
