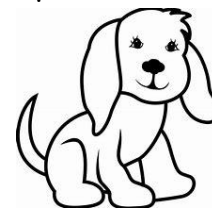

Our Week: Letter D

We are learning about pets during this month. We are figuring out how to work things out with our friends as we share some of the new toys and manipulatives in the classroom. Our small group centers included matching animals to their homes/habitats and using a scissors to cut around circles. We created a cat puppet out of a paper towel roll that looks like the cat named "Cookie" from one of our books. We practiced writing our numbers and paid special attention to the number six



as we counted out stickers and drew six crosses etc. We went on a snowflake "number hunt" looking for numbers to cross off on our charts. We reviewed the days of the week and retold the story of "Cookie", a naughty kitty who liked to get into trouble!
