
Please watch for the snack bag that will be sent home the day before your scheduled snack day. Provide a morning and afternoon snack. Thank you!

Our Week


LETTER: Ss and review

The class has been so excited about the sound of the letter S! They are hearing it at the beginning, middle and end of words. They are pointing it out wherever they see it! 😊

Our small group centers included a number recognition/counting activity in which the children had to match the correct number of pumpkin erasers to each numbered pumpkin. We also played a farm bingo game which involved following directions and listening. We reviewed the numbers 1-4 and put some number tiles in order from 1-9. Those 6's and 9's tricked us a little.

We are counting on the calendar everyday, reciting the ABC's and taking turns pointing to each letter. After reading the story, "When the Leaf Blew In", We followed directions for placing our animals and figures in the correct place on our farm scene. (positional words)

We painted with farm animal cookie cutters and have been creating animals and farm fields to decorate our room! You should check out our cute chickens in the chicken coop and pigs in the pig pen. We painted corn stalks and cut out ears of corn too.



We have been practicing every day for our song on Sunday. It is called, "Seek Ye First." Maybe your child will sing it for you!
