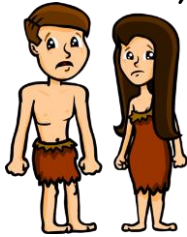
Reminders & Notes

Our Week: Letter B

Our small group centers included sorting plastic letters by whether they were straight, curvy or both. This activity helps the children begin to recognize the differences in each letter and works on recognition skills. We also worked on writing the number 2 and identifying groups of two. We completed the next page in our journals -talking about squares. Check out our great coconut trees in the hallway. We used our hands to create the leaves and painted the tall tree trunks. We worked on our fine motor skills by using different sized tongs and tweezers to pick up "coconuts" and magnet letters and transferred them to our coconut trees. On Thursday we explored the inside and the outside of some real coconuts. We cracked them open and smelled the coconut water - some thought it smelled good and others didn't. 😊 Most of us were brave enough to try some of the coconut "meat" too! We had our first safety drill of the school year. We learned what to do if there would be a tornado warning. I am proud of the kids for listening so well during the drill!
