Give Our Students a Clean Learning Environment

The school classrooms need attention twice a week to help keep them clean. The carpet gets vacuumed, garbage and recycling is emptied, and, if needed, any tile areas are mopped. This is usually done on Wednesday and Friday/Saturday. We are flexible on scheduling. You can volunteer for once a month or once a week. The work can be done early in the morning, after school, or in the evening. There are seven classrooms, but you can adopt one classroom that you take care of each week.
