Emergency ID Kits

The Wisconsin Department of Justice is providing to every family in 4K-8 a free ID kit. The kit allows you to collect information about your child in case they go missing or something happens to them. The kit is filled out and kept by you at home. In an emergency, it can be handed to law enforcement agencies to help them reunite you with your child. The kits either went home with your child today or will go home early next week. We may have enough kits to give to 3K students. If we do, we will send them home with them.
