

What is Scrip?

- Scrip cards are an alternative form of payment for the same things you buy every day. It's similar to writing a check, using a debit card or gift card.
- Families order scrip cards at full face value – in other words - \$50 cash buys a \$50 scrip card.
- Each retailer provides a percent discount per face value of the Scrip card.
- The difference between the retailer discount and the face value is revenue for St. Paul's.

What is available?

- Over 750 retailers participate in scrip including locals such as IGA and Cravings
- New retailers and promotions are updated each month

How does St Paul's Scrip program work?

- Scrip cards for select retailers are available for purchase on Sunday and in the office during the week.
- Families order scrip each week either online at <http://www.shopwithscrip.com/> , by using MyScripWallet on their phone or order forms available on St. Paul's web site or in the welcome center.
- Families deposit payment in the box in the welcome center or the office.
- The Scrip Coordinator places our order every week at www.glscrip.com.
- Scrip cards are placed in your mailbox about mid-week or sent home with the school children of St. Paul's .
- Families shop at participating retailers and redeem the scrip for full face value.
- Families may also give the cards as a gift or mail them to college students.
- The rebate may be split 50/50 between the tuition family and the church.
- Families may choose any of the following to disperse your 50% discount:
 - ✓ St. Paul's tuition for your family – rebate is split 50/50 between the family tuition payments and the school general fund. Even if your toddler hasn't started school yet we will track your discounts to apply for tuition when your child starts school at St. Paul's.
 - ✓ School General Fund
 - Example: Your family orders a Cabela's card for \$25 with an 11% discount, 5.5%, or \$1.38 cents, is used as above.
- St. Paul's benefits from the remaining discount by applying it to our current need – as of July 2018 the current need is for the school general fund.
- You may request a statement at the end of each year of your scrip contributions for tax purposes.

* of the \$318.60 one half, \$159.30, will be applied to tuition payments for St. Paul's school child and \$159.30 will be applied to payment on the line of credit loan.

*** With 100 families using \$650 of scrip for things they buy every day \$31,860 would provide \$15,930 toward tuition and the same to our line of credit – we could eliminate this debt in just over 4 years!!
